The smaller contributions, which are not authorship, should be recognized in a note (see section 2.03 of the APA). It is responsibility of the authors to determinate the authorship and the order in which the names of two or more authors will appear in the work. The principal authorship and the order of the credits of authorship must accurately reflect the contribution of people involve.
